 - In North America there are 4 FIS-University team competition series. In the USA, the EISA and USCSA series in the east and RMISA in the west. Canada has the RESQ series in eastern Canada. All competitions are team races with official team rosters entered. In order for there to be fair competition between the teams, each team needs be able to select and enter their select participants. Many teams in the USA have CAN skiers and teams in CAN have USA skiers. There are also many foreign nations represented such as NOR, SWE, AUT etc that need to have priority for entering their teams.

Proposing to make an amendment to the existing quota rule to give priority to home league athletes. Give priority to the home league athletes if they exceed the international 16 quota.

- Participants who are student members of the official university team entry in team competitions will be will be given priority in each nations quota selection. *
- FIS Uni Championship Category Proposal
 Create a new competition Category, FIS-Uni Championship, that allows for
 invitation only entry for series championships. Entries would be limited to only
 those competitors who have qualified through the rules of each FIS-University
 series or conference. Nations quotas (FIS-Uni 4.1) would be limited to invited
 participants only. Host nation, non-Uni quota (FIS-Uni 2.3) would not be
 available.
