Overall, a good season. The weather was a challenge but from 104 scheduled competitions, 94 were done in eight nations (USA, Japan, 6 European nations).

# 7. Information FISU World University Winter Games Turin 2025 (13.-23.1.25)

Presentation of the OC Torino will be shared also to the guests who provided their mail addresses.

## Questions:

- Matjaz Kranjc (FISU): Chief of the Race is not in the presentation, is he/she already defined?
  - →Yes, included in the structural chart OC team will send it
- Urs Schüpbach:
  - Athletes Village Alpine in Bardonecchia?
    - →Yes
  - o Training venues also in Bardonecchia?
    - → Yes. Start 8.1 Opening Ceremony is 13.01
  - If the SL course is on the Mogul course, is there enough time for the slope preparation?
    - →They have 5 days between Mogul and SL, this should be enough. It is foreseen to prepare it with water.
  - o Equipment control from FIS organized?
    - → Yes
  - o How did the test event run? Changes?
    - → No, no changes based on test event.
    - <u>Matjaz Kranjc (FISU)</u>: test was good and very positive. The only challenge was that there was no chance to test the slalom course due to a lack of snow.
  - Figures about inscription?
    - →Not alpine specifically but 64 countries currently registered. By June, the numbers for sport will be there.
  - o Broadcasting?
    - →Eurosport yes, but more details only later.
  - Ceremonies (opening and closing): Both in Torino: opening indoor, closing outdoor. Make sure to present the athletes something to stay in mind → use the ceremonies.
- OC: Is fluor control requested as this is not outlined in the FISU requirements?
   This is a decision that needs to be taken by FISU if they want it or not it is not mandatory as the level is continental cup level.



Added by Matjaz Kranjc (FISU): There was a meeting in continental cup level and it was discussed that the Fluor control team also wants to cover lower levels. If they do, they will bring everything and the only thing that needs to be organized is space for them to test.

- Anja (new from Para) should be there also as referee for Para.
- Airbag: Discussion that the continental cup category must have it starting with the next season. If this decision remains like this, Super-G needs it or they lose the level 1 category. Urs Schüpbach will ask this in the committee, it is an open point for the moment.

#### 8. Discussion about future for FIS-UNI Races in the FIS Calendar

Changes coming up relating to the structure of the committees: Numbers of members inside the committees shall change. Currently average 18-20, reduce it for the next period (2026 onwards) and also work on diversity and gender questions.

# Urs Schüpbach presents a proposal that he received:

7-9 members to all technical committees with some special committees having more (i.e, TD committees). Meetings should be done two times per year but in the future, one in person and one remote to reduce travel costs. Council will decide this in his first meeting after its election (July). It is still an open question how it is decided who is on the committee if there are more applicants then places.
